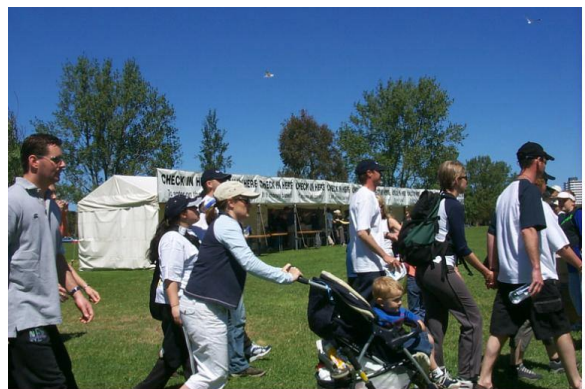


**JDRF Support by the Kiwanis Club of Brighton Vic Inc and the Kiwanis Club of Hampton Vic**
