

VISA TO INDONESIA

FREE VISA FOR SHORT VISIT

Effective from 1st February 2004, nationals of the following **9 (nine) countries and 2 (two) territory do not require** a visa to enter Indonesia for a **short visit (tourism, social, cultural, business and government) of up to 30 (thirty) days** :

1. **Brunei Darussalam**
2. **Chile**
3. **Hong Kong SAR**
4. **Macao SAR**
5. **Malaysia**
6. **Morocco**
7. **Peru**
8. **Philippine**
9. **Singapore**
10. **Thailand**
11. **Vietnam**

Please be advised that Visa Free Short Visits **may only be extended** upon approval from the Minister of Justice and Human Rights/Director General of Immigration of the Republic of Indonesia **based on natural disaster, illness or accident**.

Entry Requirements for Visa Free Short Visit

1. Passport must be valid for a minimum of 6 (six) months as from the date of entry into Indonesia.
2. Onward or return tickets are compulsory.

VISA ON ARRIVAL

Nationals of the following countries are permitted to enter Indonesia using Visa On Arrival (VOA). Visa On Arrival (VOA) is used for any aspect of **government, tourism, socio-cultural, and business activities** which is issued at arrival time in Indonesia with maximal period until 30 (thirty) days and can not be extended or converted into other kind of visa:

Entry Requirements For Visa On Arrival (VOA)

1. Passport must be valid for a minimum of 6 (six) months as from the date of entry into Indonesia.
2. Onward or return tickets are compulsory.
3. VISA fee of US\$10 / person for up to 7 (seven) days stay in Indonesia and US\$25 / person for up to 30 (thirty) days stay in Indonesia → payment at the VoA's counter in the Soekarno-Hatta (Jakarta Int'l) Airport.

VISA ISSUED ON APPROVAL

Nationals of other countries not listed in Free Visa for Short Visit nor in Visa on Arrival need to apply the VISA at the Indonesia Embassy at the designated country before traveling to Indonesia.

The requirements vary depending local consideration at each Embassy, in general are:

1. Passport must be valid for a minimum of 6 (six) months as from the date of entry into Indonesia.
2. Round trip ticket.
3. Invitation Letter from the Jakarta ASPAC Organizing Committee (*will provided upon request by the participant*).
4. VISA fee of US\$45 / person for up to 30 (thirty) days stay in Indonesia.

*) All the above are subject to any change on the prevail regulations and tariff by the Government of Republic of Indonesia.
